WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Tohono O'Odham Nation to hire an Accounting Manager and Internal Auditor for Papago Bingo; and

WHEREAS, the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act, 25 U.S.C.S 2701 et seq., requires background checks on the primary management officials and key employees of the gaming enterprises as well as each person or entity having a direct financial interest in, or management responsibility for the management contract; and

WHEREAS, Goddard & Associates, a private investigative agency located in Tucson, Arizona, can perform under contract to the Nation, the necessary background investigations at a cost of \$250.00 per individual (exclusive of obtaining criminal records which can be obtained through the Tohono O'Odham Police Department in cooperation with the Federal Bureau of Investigation and Arizona Department of Public Safety, at a cost of \$27.00 per individual fingerprinted); and

WHEREAS, immediate funding is needed to proceed with the background checks on the above-described individuals and persons, the cost for which shall be reimbursable from Papago Bingo; and

WHEREAS, a budget of \$6,250.00 is required to perform the above-described background checks on the estimated twenty-five (25) persons and/or entities necessary to comply with the Indian Gaming Regulatory Act.

2 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
3 Council that the contract between the Nation and
4 Goddard & Associates and a budget in the amount of
5 \$6,250.00 submitted to this Council by the Executive
6 Office are hereby approved and adopted.

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
8 does authorize the expenditure of funds from Account
9 No. 92-0004 to pay for this contract.

10 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
11 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's officials, to wit:
12 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official
13 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
14 contract, provided however, that any amendments
15 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract
16 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
17 Council.

18 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
19 on the 22nd. day of May, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
20 present with a vote of 1,610.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
21 114.0 [5] absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
22 Section 1(d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
23 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
24 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
25 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
26 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
