3 WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 91-180 the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
4 Council adopted the recommendations of the Water
5 Resources Committee regarding recharge, the 9B Farm and
6 other alternatives for use of the Central Arizona
7 Project ("CAP") water granted under the Southern
8 Arizona Water Rights Settlement Act of 1982 ("SAWRSA");
9 and

10 WHEREAS, the foregoing Resolution directed that the engineering
11 design and economic analysis for the 9B Farm be
12 reassessed by a technical expert to determine whether
13 the Farm would be financially feasible; and

14 WHEREAS, the Resolution further directed that a study by a
15 technical expert be commissioned to assess the
16 financial feasibility of acquiring and operating a farm
17 in Avra Valley; and

18 WHEREAS, the Water Resources Committee recommends that a
19 Consultant Contract be entered into with Natural
20 Resources Consulting Engineers to conduct the 9B Farm
21 reassessment and the Avra Valley study; and

22 WHEREAS, funding for the recommended Contract is a permissible
23 expenditure of dividends and interest on the Trust Fund
24 established under Section 309 of SAWRSA (the "SAWRSA
25 Trust Fund"), in that the Contract is designed to
26 assist in the Nation's "development of water
27 resources".

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED:

1. The Tohono O'odham Legislative Council hereby approves a Consultant Contract with Natural Resources Consulting Engineers, in the amount of \$101,194 and in the form attached hereto, for the purposes of conducting a preliminary reassessment of the 9B Farm and a preliminary study of the financial feasibility of an Avra Valley farm.
2. The foregoing sum of \$101,194 shall be paid from the SAWRSA Trust Fund.


The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 22nd day of May, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,149.5 for; 169.5 against; 405.0 not voting; 05 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI and Section 2 of Article XVII of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


