ORDER NO. 91-206 2 WHEREAS, the Policies and Procedures of the Legislative Council 3 states in Article I, Section 1.A LEGISLATIVE CALENDAR, 4 Sub sections 1 and 3: 5 Prior to an official adjournment, the Legislative Council shall adopt a Legislative Calendar which 6 shall commence on the first working day of June on 7 which the Legislative Council will be called into legislative session. The Calendar shall specify 8 dates for the general sessions, recess periods, recognized holidays, and the days of adjournment. 9 3. The Legislative Calendar shall be based only on 10 working days and scheduled paid holidays; and WHEREAS, the Rules Committee has prepared a Legislative Calendar 11 in accordance with the Policies and Procedures of the 12 13 Legislative Council. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative 14 Council does hereby adopt the Legislative Council 15 Calendar which commences on June 01, 1991 and ends on 16 17 May 31, 1992. BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that this calendar is subject to any 18 19 amendments to the Personnel Policies and Procedures regarding the Columbus Day Holiday. 20 The foregoing Legislative Order was passed by the Tohono O'odham 21 Council on the 23rd. day of May, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,472.0 for; 127.0 against; 125.0 not voting; and 08 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant 24 Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 25
