5 Farm; and

7 WHEREAS, it was critical that the Sif Oidak Egg Farm issue be  
8 addressed on this day; and

9 WHEREAS, motion was made to address the remaining agenda items, 5-  
10 9, at the June General Session in order to discuss the Sif  
11 Oidak Egg Farm issue.

Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of  
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
