(Certifying May 25, 1991 General Election)

WHEREAS, The Tohono O'odham Nation did on Saturday, May 25, 1991 conduct a general election for the offices of Chairman and Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation as well as Representatives and Alternates to the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the Election did issue and post its Certification of Election Results in accordance with Section 6 (E) of Article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance, certifying to the election of the candidates who received the highest number of votes for elective office; and

WHEREAS, under Section 6(N) of Article VII of the Uniform Election Ordinance, it is incumbent upon this Council to issue Certificates of Election to the candidates who received the highest number of votes for each Council seat within twenty days after the Election Board has posted its Certificates of Election Results provided, however, that no election contest statement has been filed against the candidates within the time allowed and provided for, and provided further that they hold no other elective office of the Nation.

WHEREAS, pursuant to Section 1(B) of Article VII of the uniform Election Ordinance, the Certificate of District Residents was presented which determines the number of votes each district is entitled to cast as the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council in accordance with Section 2 of Article IV of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and

2 WHEREAS, concerns were raised as to the accuracy of said
3 Certificate; and

4 WHEREAS, a recommendation was made to retain the existing number
5 of votes allocated to each district, totalling 1,724.0.

6 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Chairman and Secretary of
7 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council are hereby
8 authorized and directed on behalf of the Council to
9 execute and deliver a Certificate of Election to the
10 following persons elected either at large as Chairman and
11 Vice Chairman of the Tohono O'odham Nation, or from their
12 respective Districts as Representatives and Alternates to
13 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council, who shall hold
14 their offices for a term of four (4) years and until their
15 successors are certified and seated, namely:


