13 Joaquin who respectfully declined the nomination.

15 Patricio, who respectfully declined.

17 Manuel, Jr.


18 WHEREAS, in accordance with Article XII of Section 2.B,
19 "Nominations/Closure of Nominations" of the Legislative
20 Rules, a motion was recognized to close nominations

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
24 Council that it hereby acknowledges the three candidates
25 and closes nominations for the Vice Chairman of the
26 Legislative Council.

27 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the
28 3rd day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; -0-
absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1
(a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation,
adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and
approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs
(Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act
of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
