(Certifying the Appointment of four Members to the Agriculture  
Committee by Retention/Seniority Preference)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-218

WHEREAS, on June 3, 1991, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
proceeded with Appointments of Legislative Committees; and

WHEREAS, each duly elected member of the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
Council submitted a "Declaration of Candidacy" form to  
specify their choices for membership to the respective  
Legislative committees; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules, Article XII, Sections 3.b and c.  
provide for "Retention of Current Committee Membership"  
and "Seniority Preference Appointment"; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Order No. 91-217, "Waiving Seniority  
Preference and Committee Retention" was defeated, thus,  
requests for appointments by these two provisions were  
considered in appointing the Legislative Committees.

with a vote of 1,660.5 for; -0- against; 63.5 not voting; -0-


