

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL  
(Certifying the Appointment of Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Budget &  
Finance Committee by Retention)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-219

1  
2 WHEREAS, on June 3, 1991, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council  
3 proceeded with Appointments of Legislative Committees; and

4 WHEREAS, each duly elected member of the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
5 Council was provided a "Declaration of Candidacy" form to  
6 specify their choices for membership to the respective  
7 Legislative committees; and

8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules, Article XII, Sections 3.b and c.  
9 provide for "Retention of Current Committee Membership"  
10 and "Seniority Preference Appointment"; and

11 WHEREAS, Legislative Order No. 91-217, "Waiving Seniority Prefer-  
12 ence and Committee Retention" was defeated, thus, requests  
13 for appointments by these two provisions were considered  
14 in appointing the Legislative Committees.

15 WHEREAS, for the Budget & Finance Committee, the following requests  
16 for Retention and/or Seniority Preference were received  
17 from:

20 WHEREAS, as Legislative Chairwoman and Vice Chairman, Councilwoman  
21 Antone and Councilman Lewis are ineligible for appointment  
22 to the Budget & Finance Committee.

23 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative  
24 Council, under the retention provision of the Legislative  
25 Rules, hereby certifies the appointment of Councilman  
26 Albert Manuel, Jr. to the Budget & Finance Committee for  
27 a two-year term.

28 The foregoing ORDER was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the  
3rd day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present
