

LEGISLATIVE ORDER OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL
(Certifying the Appointment of Three Members to the Commerce
Committee by Seniority Preference/Retention)

LEGISLATIVE ORDER NO. 91-220

WHEREAS, on June 3, 1991, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
proceeded with Appointments of Legislative Committees; and

WHEREAS, each duly certified member of the Tohono O'odham
Legislative Council was provided a "Declaration of
Candidacy" form to specify their choices for membership
to the respective Legislative committees; and

WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules, Article XII, Sections 3.b and c.
provide for "Retention of Current Committee Membership"
and "Seniority Preference Appointment"; and

WHEREAS, Legislative Order No. 91-217, "Waiving Seniority
Preference and Committee Retention" was defeated, thus,
requests for appointments by these two provisions were
considered in appointing the Legislative Committees.

WHEREAS, for the Commerce Committee, the following requests for
Retention and/or Seniority Preference were received from:

for appointment as they were elected to the positions of
Legislative Chairwoman and Vice Chairman, respectively.

Kenneth Williams


to the Commerce Committee for a two year term.
