2 WHEREAS, on June 3, 1991, Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
3 proceeded with Appointments of Legislative Committees; and

4 WHEREAS, each duly elected member of the Tohono O'odham Legislative
5 Council submitted a "Declaration of Candidacy" form to
6 specify their choices for membership to the respective
7 Legislative committees; and

8 WHEREAS, the Legislative Rules, Article XII, Sections 3.b and c.
9 provide for "Retention of Current Committee Membership"
10 and "Seniority Preference Appointment"; and

11 WHEREAS, Legislative Order No. 91-217, "Waiving Seniority
12 Preference and Committee Retention" was defeated, thus,


