NO. 91-245_ 3 WHEREAS, the Indian Health Service has proposed the relocation of 4 the Office of Health Programs Research and Development 5 (OHPRD) to Albuquerque, New Mexico; and WHEREAS, simultaneous with the relocation of OHPRD, the Tucson 6 7 Program Office of IHS is to be merged into the Phoenix 8 Area Office: and WHEREAS, said proposed relocation and merger will result in the 9 reduction in health care and support services provided by 10 IHS to the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation; and 11 WHEREAS, the needs of the members of the Tohono O'odham Nation 12 remain grossly unmet in both the clinical services areas 13 and the sanitation facilities area based upon recent IHS 14 reports to the Congress of the United States; and 15 16 WHEREAS, the planned merger with the Phoenix Area Office will result in a decline in services to the Tohono O'odham 17 Nation and other tribes served by that Office; and 18 WHEREAS, the proposed relocation and merger will leave the Tohono 19 O'odham Nation with only a Service Unit in the IHS 20 structure, and further impair the minimal progress made 21 to improve the health status of the Tohono O'odham 22 **2**3 members; and WHEREAS, the Executive Branch by and through the Health Department and the Office of the Chairman in consultation with the 25

NO. 91-245 (Expressing Opposition to the Proposal of the Indian Health Service (USPHS) to Relocate the Office of Health Programs Research and Development and Merge the Tucson Program Office into the Phoenix Area Office) Page (2) 2 3 commenting and opposing this proposed reorganization of 4 IHS (attached hereto as Exhibit A). 5 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative 6 Council of the Tohono O'odham Nation expresses strong 7 opposition to the proposed relocation of OHPRD and the 8 merger of the Tucson Program Office into the Phoenix Area 9 Office, due to its negative impact on the health care and 10 support services provided to the members of the Nation. 11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Legislative Council formally adopts 12 the Tohono O'odham Nation's Position Paper on this IHS 13 reorganization and authorizes the Executive Branch of the 14 Tohono O'odham Nation to request withdrawal of this IHS 15 proposal by communicating with IHS officials, officials 16 of the Department of Health and Human Services and Members 17 of Congress on this matter. 18 19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 5th day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was 20 present with a vote of 1,664.5 for; -0- against; 59.5 not voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by 21 Section 1 (j) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 22 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 23 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 24 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 25 26 Ann Antone, Legislative Chairwoman 27 28
