3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has operated a Head Start
4 Program to provide and serve educational and preschool
5 learning experiences for children between ages of 3-5; and

6 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,
7 Administration for Children, Youth and Families has
8 announced supplemental funds for (1) Program Improvement,
9 (2) Expansion Assuring Program Quality and (3) Training
10 and Technical Assistance; and

11 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared proposals for the
12 supplemental funds to be submitted to the Department of
13 Health and Human Services; and

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative
15 Council does hereby approve the Head Start Supplemental
16 Grant Proposals for (1) Program Improvement; (2) Expansion
17 Assuring Program Quality; and (3) Training and Technical
18 Assistance.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the
21 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are
22 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract,
23 provided however, that any amendments affecting the
24 funding or funding levels of this contract shall be
25 submitted for further prior approval by this Council.
