1 RES. NO. 91-261 2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation established a policy to require 3 the inclusion of indirect costs in all third party funded 4 agreements; and 5 WHEREAS, the policy provides for an exception and waiver of the 6 requirement by the Legislative Council if it is in the 7 best interest of the Nation to do so, that is when the 8 benefits to the Nation exceed the need to collect the 9 revenues from the funding agency; and 10 WHEREAS, funding from the State of Arizona, Department of Economic 11 Security for the FY 1992 Title XX - Child Day Care Program 12 is insufficient to cover both direct and indirect cost 13 needs of the program. NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative 14 Council finds that it is in the best interest of the 15 Nation to waive the indirect cost funding requirement for 16 17 FY 1992 Title XX - Child Day Care Program. The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 7th day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,188.0 for; 338.0 against; 198.0 not voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 22 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984). 23 TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL 24 25 Legislative Chairwoman 26 27
