

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham FY 1992 Children's Home Re-Contract Proposal)**

3 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
4 Children's Home Program under FY 1991 P. L. 93-638
5 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and

6 **WHEREAS,** such tribal operations have been successful and
7 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;
8 and

9 **WHEREAS,** 25, CFR 271.20 of the Federal Regulations requires that
10 all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be
11 submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for
12 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
13 termination; and

14 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to re-contract
15 for provision of services during FY 1992; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
17 approved the FY 1992 Children's Home contract proposal
18 and budget.

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
20 Council that it does authorize and request the Bureau
21 of Indian Affairs to re-contract with the Tohono
22 O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and
23 procedures for the provision of services titled:
24 Children's Home.

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this contract shall
26 commence on October 01, 1991 through September 30,
27 1992.


28 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate

3 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
4 being conducted and no executed contract has been
5 approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs unless the
6 agency authorizes and approves pre-award cost
7 consistent with the Indian Self Determination Act, as
8 amended and relevant contract regulations.

9 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
10 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:
11 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and designated official are
12 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
13 contract, provided however, that any amendments
14 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract
15 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
16 Council.


17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
18 on the 18th day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
19 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
20 voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
21 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
22 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
23 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
24 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
25 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
