

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1992 Tohono O'Odham Youth Services)

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the  
4 Tohono O'Odham Youth Services Program under an  
5 agreement with United Way of Tucson; and

6 WHEREAS, such services for the youth have been successful and  
7 beneficial; and

8 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to enter into an  
9 agreement for services during FY 1992; and

10 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Youth Services/Prevention Education  
11 has submitted a budget for review and approval by the  
12 Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

13 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
14 Council that it does support and authorize the Tohono  
15 O'Odham Nation to enter into an agreement with United  
16 Way of Tucson for Prevention Education Services.

17 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of the Agreement will be  
18 from July 01, 1991 through June 30, 1992.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
20 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
21 the program in the interim while negotiations are still  
22 being conducted and no executed agreement has been  
23 awarded by the United Way of Tucson Agency.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
25 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:  
26 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official  
27 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the  
28 agreement, provided however, that any amendments  
affecting the funding or funding levels of the

agreement shall be submitted for further prior approval  
by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 18th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,641.0 for; -0- against; 83.0 not voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


