3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
4 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
5 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
6 being conducted and no executed contract has been
7 approved by the Bureau of Indian Affairs unless the
8 agency authorizes and approves pre-award cost
9 consistent with the Indian Self Determination Act, as
10 amended and relevant contract regulations.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
12 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:
13 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and designated official are
14 hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
15 contract, provided however, that any amendments
16 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract
17 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this
18 Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
20 on the 18th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
21 present with a vote of 1,503.0 for; -0- against; 221.0 not
22 voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
23 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
24 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
25 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
26 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
27 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
