

1 RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1992 Food Distribution Program Supplemental Request)

2 RES. NO. 91-281

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does operate the Food
4 Distribution Program under a grant with the United
5 States Department of Agriculture; and

6 WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program has been successful in
7 providing services to eligible O'Odham members; and

8 WHEREAS, the United States Department of Agriculture has
9 informed the Tohono O'Odham Nation that any cost
10 associated with the Nation's building is the
11 responsibility of the Nation; and

12 WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program has prepared a tribal
13 supplemental request to cover cost of telephone and
14 building for a total request of \$6,068.75.

15 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
16 Council does hereby approve the supplemental request
17 for telephone and building costs and authorizes
18 expenditures in accordance with the attached budget
19 entitled "Dollar Match".

20 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
21 on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
22 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not
23 voting; -0- absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
24 by Section 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
