

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Elderly Title VI - FY 1992)

RES. NO. 91-287

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3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has successfully operated a
4 program for the elderly members of the Nation; and

5 WHEREAS, funding for the operation of the Elderly Program has
6 been possible in part by Article VI of the Older
7 American's Act of 1965 as amended; and

8 WHEREAS, the Elderly Program desires to seek continued funding
9 by submitting a proposal to the Office of Human
10 Development Services, Administration on Aging; and

11 WHEREAS, the Elderly proposal will benefit elder members of the
12 Tohono O'Odham Nation by providing for their
13 nutritional and social support services.

14 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
15 Council that it does hereby approve the proposal for
16 continued funding for the Elderly Program to provide
17 services to eligible members of the Tohono O'Odham
18 Nation.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this grant shall commence
20 on April 01, 1991 and end on March 31, 1992.

21 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
22 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
23 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
24 being conducted and no executed grant has been awarded
25 by the Office of Human Development Services,
26 Administration on Aging.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
28 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:
the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official

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are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).

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
