RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Waiver of Indirect Cost for the Women, Infant, and Children)

RES. NO. 91-288 the Tohono O'Odham Nation established a policy to WHEREAS, 4 require the inclusion of indirect costs in all third party funded agreements; and the policy provides for an exception and waiver of the WHEREAS, 7 requirement by the Legislative Council if it is in the 8 best interest of the Nation to do so, that is when the benefits to the Nation exceeds the need to collect the revenues from the funding agency; and funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona for WHEREAS, FY 1992 Women, Infant, and Children Program is insufficient to cover both direct and indirect cost

needs of the program.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council finds that it is in the best interest of the Nation to waive the indirect cost funding requirement for FY 1992 Women, Infant, and Children Program.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,597.0 for; -0- against; 127.0 not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
