

1 RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
2 (Tohono O'Odham FY 1992 WIC Program)

3 RES. NO. 91-289

4 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has provided preventive  
5 health care for women, infants and children during  
6 Fiscal Year 1991; and

7 WHEREAS, the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona receives funds from  
8 the United States Department of Agriculture for  
9 programs designed to benefit women, infants and  
10 children; and

11 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has entered into a Memorandum  
12 of Agreement with the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona  
13 for funds to operate and fund its Women, Infants and  
14 Children (WIC) Program; and

15 WHEREAS, the services provided to eligible clients has been  
16 beneficial and services continue to be necessary to  
17 help alleviate nutritional health risks and improve the  
18 health of individuals at risk.

19 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
20 Council that it hereby approves the application for  
21 funding from the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona, to  
22 continue to operate and provide services to eligible  
23 women, infants and children.

24 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the term of this Memorandum of  
25 Agreement will commence on October 01, 1991 through  
26 September 30, 1992 unless extended by mutual agreement  
27 of both parties.

28 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
the program in the interim while negotiations are still

3 being conducted and no executed memorandum has been  
4 awarded by the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona.

5 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
6 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:  
7 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official  
8 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the this  
9 Memorandum of Agreement, provided however, that any  
10 amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of  
11 the Memorandum of Agreement shall be submitted for  
12 further prior approval by this Council.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council  
15 on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
16 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not  
17 voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
18 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
19 O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January  
20 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
21 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
22 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
