**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services Program under FY 1991, P. L. 93-638 contract with Public Health, Indian Health Services; and

**WHEREAS,** such tribal operations have been successful and beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; and

**WHEREAS,** 42 CFR 36.205 of the Federal Regulations requires that all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for approval at least 120 days prior to the contract termination; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to re-contract for provisions of services during FY 1992; and

**WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and approved the Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services/Children's Initiative Program FY 1992 contract proposal and budget.

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does authorize and request the Public Health, Indian Health Service to re-contract with the Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations and procedures for provisions of services titled: Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services/Children's Initiative.

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4 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this re-contract shall  
5 commence on October 01, 1991 through September 30,

7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
8 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate  
9 the program in the interim while negotiations are still  
10 being conducted and no executed contract has been  
11 awarded by the Indian Health Service unless the agency  
12 authorizes and approves pre-award cost consistent with  
13 the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended and  
14 relevant contract regulations.

15 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council  
16 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:  
17 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official  
18 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the  
19 contract, provided however, that any amendments  
20 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract  
21 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this  
22 Council.

23 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
24 on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
25 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not  
26 voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council  
27 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono  
28 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January  
18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -  
Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section  
16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
