## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (FY 1992 Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services Children's Initiative)

1 2 RES. NO. 91-297 3 the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the WHEREAS. 4 Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services Program under FY 5 1991, P. L. 93-638 contract with Public Health, Indian 6 Health Services; and 7 WHEREAS. such tribal operations have been successful and 8 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people; 9 and 10 42 CFR 36.205 of the Federal Regulations requires that WHEREAS, 11 all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be 12 submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for 13 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract 14 termination; and 15 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to re-contract 16 for provisions of services during FY 1992; and 17 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and 18 approved the Tohono O'Odham Psychological 19 Services/Children's Initiative Program FY 1992 contract 20 proposal and budget. 21 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative 22 Council that it does authorize and request the Public 23 Health, Indian Health Service to re-contract with the 24 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations 25 and procedures for provisions of services titled: 26 Tohono O'Odham Psychological Services/Children's **27** 

Initiative.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this re-contract shall commence on October 01, 1991 through September 30, 1992.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program in the interim while negotiations are still being conducted and no executed contract has been awarded by the Indian Health Service unless the agency authorizes and approves pre-award cost consistent with the Indian Self-Determination Act, as amended and relevant contract regulations.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the contract, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
