

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Tohono O'Odham FY 1992 Management of Health Services)**

4 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation is presently operating the
5 Management of Health Services Program under FY 1991
6 P. L. 93-638 contract with the Public Health, Indian
7 Health Services; and

8 **WHEREAS,** such tribal operations have been successful and
9 beneficial to the Tohono O'Odham Nation and its people;
10 and

11 **WHEREAS,** 42, CFR 36.205 of the Federal Regulations requires that
12 all proposals to recontract under P. L. 93-638 be
13 submitted to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council for
14 approval at least 120 days prior to the contract
15 termination; and

16 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Nation does desire to extend for
17 provisions of services during FY 1992; and

18 **WHEREAS,** the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and
19 approved the Management of Health Services Program FY
20 1992 proposal and budget.

21 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative
22 Council that it does authorize and request the Public
23 Health, Indian Health Service to re-contract with the
24 Tohono O'Odham Nation under P. L. 93-638 regulations
25 and procedures for the provision of services titled:
26 Management of Health Services.

27 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** that the duration of this contract shall
28 commence on October 01, 1991 through September 30,
1992.

3 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
4 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate
5 the program in the interim while negotiations are still
6 being conducted and no executed contract has been
7 awarded by the Indian Health Service unless the agency
8 authorizes and approves pre-award cost consistent with
9 the Indian Self Determination Act, as amended and
10 relevant contract regulations.

11 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council
12 that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit:
13 the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official
14 are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the
15 contract, provided however, that any amendments
16 affecting the funding or funding levels of this
17 contract shall be submitted for further prior approval
18 by this Council.

19 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
20 on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
21 present with a vote of 1,661.5 for; -0- against; 62.5 not
22 voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
23 by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
24 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
25 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
26 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
27 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
