

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Tohono O'Odham FY 1992 Head Start Program Grant)

RES. NO. 91-299

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3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has recognized the importance  
4 of Head Start education and stimulation; and

5 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated a Head Start  
6 Program to provide and serve educational and pre-school  
7 learning experiences for children between the ages of  
8 3-5 years; and

9 WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,  
10 Administration for Children, Youth and Families has  
11 provided funding for the operation of the Head Start  
12 Program; and

13 WHEREAS, the Administration for Children, Youth and Families  
14 will provide funds for the continued operation of the  
15 Head Start Program to legal and qualifying applicants;  
16 and

17 WHEREAS, the Head Start Program has prepared a proposal for FY  
18 1992 program operations to be submitted to the  
19 Department of Health and Human Services; and

20 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council has reviewed and  
21 approved the Head Start grant.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
23 Council that it does authorize and request the  
24 Department of Health and Human Services to contract  
25 with the Tohono O'Odham Nation for the provision of  
26 services titled: Head Start Program.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the duration of this grant will be  
28 from November 01, 1991 through October 31, 1992.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation will not fund or operate the program from which grants are requested herewith which have not been negotiated and executed by the Department of Health and Human Services prior to the start of the funding year.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 19th. day of June, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,661.5 for; -0- against; 62.5 not voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


