Administrative Provision to increase the Veterans Fund Budget)

2 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Veterans of the Armed Forces wish
3 to celebrate the return of the troops from Operation
4 Desert Storm during the Independence Day Holiday
5 weekend; and

6 WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$5,000 have been requested by
7 the Veterans for this purpose; and

8 WHEREAS, contingency funds in the amount of \$5,000 exist within
9 the Administrative Provision budget.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the
11 Tohono O'Odham Nation approves the transfer of funds
12 in the contingency line item and the Veterans Fund line
13 item as shown in the attached request for budget
14 modification.

15 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
16 on the 8th. day of July, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
17 present with a vote of 1,618.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
18 106.0 [6] absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by
19 Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono
20 O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January
21 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary -
22 Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section
23 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
