

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Authorizing the use of the remaining balance  
of funds previously appropriated for  
O'Odham Construction & Materials)

3 WHEREAS, the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation  
4 did appropriate funds and authorize expenditures on  
5 behalf of O'Odham Construction and Materials (OCM) in  
6 the amount of \$117,217 (subject to repayment and other  
7 conditions) through Resolution No. 390-90, dated  
8 October 24, 1990; and

9 WHEREAS, funds in the amount of \$32,107.57 remained unexpended  
10 from that appropriation as of June 1, 1991; and

11 WHEREAS, the reason that they have not been spent is that they  
12 were appropriated specifically to fund activities  
13 needed to satisfy contract obligations for the Indian  
14 Oasis School project; and

15 WHEREAS, these contract obligations have been eliminated by  
16 negotiation, without the need to perform additional  
17 activities; and

18 WHEREAS, OCM has operated at or above a "break-even" level since  
19 January 1991, but still has need for funds, over and  
20 above cash provided by operations, to pay off earlier  
21 debts, and to preserve sufficient working capital; and

22 WHEREAS, there is an urgent need to pay OCM's creditors before  
23 the Nation's credit and reputation are harmed.

24 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the  
25 Tohono O'Odham Nation that the Executive Office is  
26 authorized to expend, during FY 1991, the remaining  
27 funds appropriated in Resolution No. 390-90 in support  
28 of OCM according to the attached budget modification.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the total appropriation is still to  
be considered a loan.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Executive Office will submit a  
revised plan of operation and budget for OCM (including  
a repayment plan for the loan) for the Legislative  
Council to consider as part of the budget process for  
FY 1991.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
on the 8th. day of July, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
present with a vote of 1,618.0 for; -0- against; -0- not  
voting; 106.0 [6] absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the  
Council by Section 1(d)(2) of Article VI of the Constitution of  
the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation  
on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant  
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant  
to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




