## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL (Child Care Block Grant)

WHEREAS,	the Tohono O'odham Nation is presently operating the Early
	Childhood Head Start Program, Day Care Center for its
	young members by providing for their welfare through
	various programs and services designed to meet their
	special needs; and

WHEREAS, the Department of Health and Human Services,
Administration for Children and Family has announced that
supplemental appropriations under the Omnibus Budget
Reconciliation Act of 1990, P.L. 101-508, established a
new Child Care and Development Block Grant Program to
provide grants to tribal government to administer child
care programs; and

WHEREAS, P.L. 101-508 of the Omnibus Budget Reconciliation Act of 1990, section 5082, provides provision that the Secretary shall reserve not more than 3 percent of the amount appropriated in each fiscal year for payments to Indian tribes and tribal organizations; and

WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the block grant is to assist states to provide child care services to low-income, working families, (The Family Support Act requires child care services for AFDC parents who are participating in the JOBS training, and for one year after obtaining employment); and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation early Childhood Headstart

Program has submitted a proposed budget under this program
through this competitive block grant; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is desirous to continue to provide Day Care Services to its young tribal members; and

WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Early Childhood Headstart Program has submitted for review and approval the proposed budget in the amount of \$186,775.00.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that it does hereby approves the Tohono O'odham Nation Early Childhood Headstart Program budget for federal assistance in order to supplement Day Care Services to its young tribal members.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit; the Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designed official are hereby authorized to negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 11th. day of July, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting; 02 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
