

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Waiver of Indirect Cost on Additional Funding  
of \$7,000.00 for the FY 1991 Women,  
Infant and Children Program)

3 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation established a policy to  
4 require the inclusion of indirect costs in all third  
5 party funded agreements; and

6 WHEREAS, the policy provides for an exception and waiver of the  
7 requirement by the Legislative Council if it is in the  
8 best interest of the Nation to do so, that is when the  
9 benefits to the Nation exceeds the need to collect the  
10 revenues from the funding agency; and

11 WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$7,000.00 has been  
12 received from the United States Department of  
13 Agriculture through the Inter-Tribal Council of Arizona  
14 for the FY 1991 Women, Infant and Children Program for  
15 the purpose of purchasing nutrition and education  
16 materials targeted at childhood obesity and staff  
17 development courses; and

18 WHEREAS, the additional funding amount of \$7,000.00 is  
19 insufficient to meet the purpose of allocating  
20 additional funding to cover both direct and indirect  
21 cost needs of the program.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative  
23 Council finds that it is in the best interest of the  
24 Nation to waive the indirect cost funding requirement  
25 for the FY 1991 Women, Infant and Children Program on  
26 the additional \$7,000.00 only.

27 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council  
28 on the 5th. day of August, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was  
present with a vote of 1,279.5 for; 185.0 against; 259.5 not  
voting; 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council
