3 Education Program with tribal funds; and

4 WHEREAS, amendments affecting the funding level or change in the
5 purpose for which the funds were budgeted are required
6 to be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono
7 O'odham Legislative Council; and

8 WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted for review and
9 approval.

10 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
11 Council that it hereby approves this amendment and
12 authorizes expenditures in accordance with the attached
13 budget.

14 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council
15 on the 5th. day of August, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was
16 present with a vote of 1,724.0 for; -0- against; -0- not voting;
17 04 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section
18 1(d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham
Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986,
and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian
Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


