(Approving Amendment No. 2 to the Attorney Contract with the
Law Firm of Linden, Chapa & Fields)

2 WHEREAS, during fiscal year 1991 the law firm of Linden, Chapa &
3 Fields was engaged by Attorney Contract (as amended by
4 Amendment No. 1 thereto) to assist the Attorney General
5 in providing legal representation to the Tohono O'odham
6 Nation with respect to two lawsuits pending in the
7 Nation's Tribal Court; and

8 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract (as amended) was approved by the
9 Legislative Council pursuant to Resolution No. 416-90; and

10 WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is for a term ending on September
11 30, 1991; and

12 WHEREAS, additional funding in the amount of \$9,000 is required
13 for the Attorney Contract to enable uninterrupted
14 representation in these matters; and

15 WHEREAS, sufficient funds are available in the professional
16 services line item of the fiscal year 1991 budget for the
17 Office of Attorney General to cover the proposed increase
18 in the amount of the Attorney Contract; and

19 WHEREAS, the Attorney General and the Domestic Affairs Committee
20 recommend approval of Amendment No. 2 to the Attorney
21 Contract to increase the Contract amount by \$9,000.

22 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 23 1. Amendment No. 2 to the Attorney Contract between the
24 Tohono O'odham Nation and the law firm of Linden,
25 Chapa & Fields is hereby approved in the form attached
26 hereto.
27 2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed
28 to execute Amendment No. 2.
