

RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Extending the Time for Responding to Resolution No. 91-249,
"Recommendations Regarding the Papago Livestock Complex")

2 WHEREAS, Resolution No. 91-249 supported six recommendations to the
3 Executive Branch regarding the Livestock Complex, and
4 called for Oversight Committees to develop additional
5 recommendations; and

6 WHEREAS, the Executive Branch has considered the recommendations,
7 and made preliminary plans to follow them; and

8 WHEREAS, these plans are complex and will require additional time
9 to contact: experts in Agriculture, Livestock Management,
10 Architecture and related fields; District Officials;
11 Members of the Nation; Livestock Associations; other
12 advisory groups; and individual livestock owners; and

13 WHEREAS, additional time would be useful to Oversight Committees
14 in developing further recommendations.

15 NOW, THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative
16 Council that it does support the Executive Branch in
17 performing emergency repairs to the Livestock Complex as
18 quickly as is practical.

19 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
20 supports the following Executive Branch plans:

- 21 1) to conduct architectural, business, and organizational
22 studies regarding the Livestock Complex;
- 23 2) to obtain Community participation in planning for
24 renovation and operation of the Livestock Complex; and
- 25 3) to prepare budgets for the renovation and renewed
26 operation of the Livestock Complex.

27 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council
28 supports the Executive Branch plan to report on the

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 9th day of August, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,614.0 for; -0- against; 110.0 not voting; 07 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1(c) (2) & (d) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


