WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has applied for funds for a water inventory in the Chuichu area of the Sif Oidak District pursuant to Legislative Council Resolution No. 91-007; and

WHEREAS, the Application was made to the Bureau of Indian Affairs

(BIA) on or about April 26, 1991 for such funding and
activities consistent with Legislative Council Resolution
No. 91-007; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated June 14, 1991, the BIA approved the Application; and

WHEREAS, by letter dated August 2, 1991, the BIA forwarded for review, acceptance and execution a Contract for the Chuichu Water Inventory Program in the amount of \$250,000; and

WHEREAS, the Contract provides for pre-award costs (see Section 207) which have been advanced from the budget of the Attorney General's Office (\$6,035.15) and Interstate Bank Account P.L. 99-469, 2010-39811 (\$65,000); and

WHEREAS, the Contract provides that all work will be completed by Natural Resources Consulting Engineers.

NOW THEREFORE BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- The Chuichu Water Inventory P.L. 93-638 Contract is accepted on behalf of the Tohono O'odham Nation by the Legislative Council.
- 2. The Chairman of the Nation is authorized to execute the Contract consistent with the terms of this

Resolution and is further authorized to execute modifications to same which do not effect the amount of funds provided.

- 3. The Chairman of the Nation, Water Resources
 Committee with the Attorney General and the Office
 of Grants and Contracts, are further authorized to
 negotiate and execute a subcontract with Natural
 Resources Consulting Engineers to conduct the Water
 Inventory Program.
- 4. The Accounting Department and Chief Financial Officer are authorized additionally to invoice the BIA for \$71,035.15 in pre-award costs and to replenish the budget of the Attorney General's Office and Interstate Bank Account P.L. 99-469, 2010-3981, in the respective amounts of \$6,035.15 and \$65,000.
- 5. The Chairman of the Nation is further authorized to take such actions consistent with this Resolution as may be necessary and proper to implement the Chuichu Water Inventory Program.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'odham Council on the 29th day of August, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,660.5 for; -0- against; 63.5 not voting; 01 absent, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'odham Nation on January 18, 1986, and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
