## RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM COUNCIL (Probate Backlog Elimination Program)

RES. NO. 91-369 1 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated numerous P. L. 2 93-638 contracts with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and 3 the Bureau of Indian Affairs has notified the Tohono WHEREAS, 4 O'odham Nation that funding has been allocated for a 5 Probate Backlog Elimination Program; and 6 WHEREAS, the primary purpose of the Probate Backlog Elimination 7 Program is to assist Districts and individuals in the 8 preparation of family histories, inventories and to 9 secure data which would constitute a complete probate 10 file for review and submittal to the Administrative Law 11 Judge; and 12 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation has submitted a proposal and 13 budget for the purpose of the Probate Backlog 14 Elimination Program; and 15 the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council is desirous to WHEREAS, 16 provide Probate Backlog Elimination Services to its 17 tribal members in order to close out outstanding cases; 18 and 19 WHEREAS, this proposal and contract will require unique 20 coordination between the Tohono O'odham Nation and the 21 Bureau of Indian Affairs due to its proposed sharing of 22 functions and supervision; and 23 WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Nation Probate Backlog Elimination 24 Program has submitted for review and approval the 25 application and budget. 26

NO. 91-369 (Probate Backlog Elimination Program) Page (2) 1 NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative 2 Council that it does hereby authorize and request the 3 Bureau of Indian Affairs to contract with the Tohono 4 O'odham Nation pursuant to P. L. 93-638 as amended for 5 the provision of services titled: Tohono O'odham Nation 6 Probate Backlog Elimination Program. 7 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 8 that the contract contain provisions that clearly and 9 concisely delineate the lines of authority. 10 responsibility and liability between the BIA and the 11 Tohono O'odham Nation. 12 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council 13 that the Tohono O'odham Nation's Officials, to wit: the 14 Chairman, Vice Chairman and any designated official are 15 hereby authorized to negotiate and 16 provided however, that any amendments 17 affecting the funding or funding levels of the contract 18 shall be submitted for further prior approval by this 19 Council. 20 21 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Council on the 9th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,618.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 106.0 [3] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant 25 to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
