4 **WHEREAS,** *amendments affecting the funding level or change in the purpose for*
5 *which the funds were budgeted are required to be submitted for*
6 *review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council; and*


7 **WHEREAS,** *an amendment has been submitted for review and approval to transfer*
8 *funds between line items and purchase five vehicles.*

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that*
11 *it hereby approves this amendment and authorizes expenditures in*
12 *accordance with the attached budget.*

15 *the 11th day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented*
16 *with a vote of 1,618.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 106.0 [8]*
17 *ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article*
18 *VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono*
O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant
Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of
the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




