3 **WHEREAS,** *the U.S. Congress enacted P.L. 101-601 the Native American Graves*
4 *Protection and Repatriation Act (the Act) to provide for the protection*
5 *of Native American graves and for repatriation of Native American*
6 *human remains and objects; and*

8 **WHEREAS,** *Section 8 of the Act provides for the establishment of a Review*
9 *Committee with the membership consisting of seven (7) members;*
10 *three (3) of whom shall be nominated by the Indian tribes, three (3)*
11 *of whom shall be nominated by national museum organizations and*
12 *scientific organizations, and one (1) who shall be chosen from a list*
13 *of nominees developed and consented to by the appointed committee*
14 *members; and*

16 **WHEREAS,** *the Cultural Preservation Committee (the Committee) is the Legislative*
17 *oversight committee concerning cultural issues; and*

18 **WHEREAS,** *the Committee recommends the nominations of the following*
19 *individuals based on their qualifications and knowledge of Native*
20 *American customs and traditions and cultural issues to serve on the*
21 *Review Committee, namely:*

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 13th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,724.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 05 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (c)(8) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
