

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1991 Job Opportunities Basic Skills Program  
Budget Modification No. 1 and Extension Request)**

3 **WHEREAS, Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was enacted**  
4 **into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC Program to**  
5 **emphasize work, child support, and family benefits, to amend Title IV**  
6 **of the Social Security Act, to encourage and assist needy children and**  
7 **parents under the new program to obtain the education, training and**  
8 **employment needed to void long term welfare dependence; and**

10 **WHEREAS, on September 10, 1990 JOBS Information Memorandum provided the**  
11 **Tohono O'Odham Nation an estimated allocation in the amount of**  
12 **\$99,189.00; and**

13 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did approve by Resolution**  
14 **No. 386-90 the Job Opportunities Basic Skills Program budget in the**  
15 **amount of \$99,189.00 for the period of October 01, 1990 through**  
16 **March 31, 1991; and**

18 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation was informed in January, 1991 of its**  
19 **final allocation for Fiscal Year 1991 in the amount of \$165,431.00;**  
20 **and**

21 **WHEREAS, any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant**  
22 **shall be submitted for review and approval by the Tohono O'Odham**  
23 **Legislative Council; and**

24  
25 **WHEREAS, an amendment has been submitted by the JTPA Program for the Job**  
26 **Opportunities Basic Skills Program (JOBS) to include the additional**  
27 **amount of \$66,242.00 to reflect final allocation for a grand total**  
28 **amount of \$165,431.**

3 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that  
4 *it does hereby approve the extension request and authorizes*  
5 *expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.*

6 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
7 *duration of the grant extension shall begin on April 01, 1991 through*  
8 *September 30, 1991.*

10 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED** by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the  
11 *Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice*  
12 *Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to*  
13 *negotiate and execute the grant amendment, provided however, that*  
14 *any amendments affecting the funding or funding levels of the grant*  
15 *shall be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.*

17 *The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on*  
18 *the 13th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented*  
19 *with a vote of 1,225.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 57.0 NOT VOTING; and 442.0 [9]*  
20 *ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI*  
21 *of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham*  
22 *Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary*  
23 *- Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of*  
24 *June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).*
