

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(Distribution of Royalties to Districts)**

**RES. NO. 91-405**

1  
2 **WHEREAS, during the September 12, 1991 General Session of the Legislative**  
3 **Council, the Chief Financial Officer (CFO) appeared before the Council**  
4 **and presented a status report regarding funds available for distribution**  
5 **and has attested that there is presently on deposit in interest bearing**  
6 **accounts established pursuant to Ordinance No. 55, and amended by**  
7 **Ordinance No. 13-82, a sum in excess of \$1,309,966.34.**

8  
9 **WHEREAS, the Chief Financial Officer did further inform the Council of**  
10 **outstanding receivables of certain Districts that require resolution.**

11 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative**  
12 **Council that it does hereby appropriate from the foregoing accounts**  
13 **the sum of \$1,309,966.34 which shall be divided and distributed in**  
14 **full to each of the eleven (11) Districts of the Tohono O'Odham**  
15 **Nation on the basis of their respective resident populations, as**  
16 **follows:**

2 provided, however, that such distributions shall be expended by the  
3 various District Councils under budgets or resolutions duly approved  
4 by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

6 BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that it does  
7 hereby direct the Accounting Department to transfer in full from the  
8 Accounts established pursuant to Ordinances No. 55 and No. 13-82  
9 to the respective Accounts of each Districts the sums allocated to  
10 them pursuant to this resolution.

11 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that no funds will be withheld from the Districts as  
12 payment for the receivables as it is the desire of the Legislative  
13 Council that the Accounting Department continued to meet with the  
14 respective Districts to clarify the receivables for payment.

17 The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on  
18 the 13th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented  
19 with a vote of 1,026.0 FOR; 477.0 AGAINST; 114.0 NOT VOTING; and 107.0  
20 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d) of Article VI  
21 of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham  
22 Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary  
23 - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of  
24 June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
