

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(FY 1991 Food Distribution Program Budget Modification No. 2)**

2 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation does operate the Food Distribution**
3 **Program under a grant with the United States Department of**
4 **Agriculture; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program has been successful in providing**
7 **services to eligible O'Odham members; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council did approve by Resolution**
9 **No. 91-036 the amount of \$45,000.00 from general revenues to be**
10 **added to the Administrative Provision Budget for the purchase of a**
11 **food delivery truck; and**

13 **WHEREAS, discussions were held with the United States Department of**
14 **Agriculture representatives regarding its portion of the cost in**
15 **replacing the food delivery truck; and**

16 **WHEREAS, the Food Distribution Program has prepared a budget modification to**
17 **cover cost of the food delivery truck in the amount of \$28,740.00,**
18 **as approved by the United States Department of Agriculture.**

20 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
21 **does hereby approve the amendment and authorizes expenditures in**
22 **accordance with the attached budget modification submitted by the**
23 **Food Distribution Program.**

24 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that the**
25 **Tohono O'Odham Nation's officials, to wit: the Chairman, Vice**
26 **Chairman and any designated official are hereby authorized to**
27 **negotiate and execute the grant, provided however, that any**

be submitted for further prior approval by this Council.*

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 23rd. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,610.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [5] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




