3 **WHEREAS, by Resolution No. 91-416, the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
4 **approved the fiscal year 1992 budgets for the Executive Branch,**
5 **including a budget of \$627,054 for the Office of Attorney General;**

7 **WHEREAS, an additional \$29,544 is required to fund resources necessary for the**
8 **Office of Attorney General to adequately represent the legal interests**
9 **of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends that the Legislative**
12 **Council add the sum of \$29,544 to the fiscal year 1992 operating**
13 **budget of the Attorney General's Office, resulting in a total budget of**
14 **\$656,598.**

 - 2. The additional appropriation and all amounts previously appropriated and authorized for expenditure by the Office of Attorney General shall be expended in accordance with the attached operating budget of the Office of Attorney General for fiscal year 1992, totalling \$656,598.**
