4 **WHEREAS,** *the Childrens' Homes of the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Program*
5 *in the Executive Branch of the Tohono O'Odham Nation receives*
6 *funding through a contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs to pay for*
7 *the program's operating expenses; and*

9 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Program feels that this budget is*
10 *not adequate to support the type and level of service needed by the*
11 *members of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and*

12 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Program has submitted a*
13 *supplementary budget (attached hereto and incorporated by reference)*
14 *for approval by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation*
15 *with a request for an appropriation of funds; and*

17 **WHEREAS,** *the Health & Human Services Committee of the Legislative Council,*
18 *with the oversight responsibility for the Childrens' Homes of the*
19 *Tohono O'Odham Social Service Program, has reviewed this budget*
20 *and appropriation request and recommended their approval and*
21 *adoption; and*

23 **WHEREAS,** *the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council has*
24 *reviewed this budget and appropriation request and recommended*
25 *their approval and adoption.*

26 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED** *by the Legislative Council of the Tohono*

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that to the extent that salaries and wages are to be paid in this budget, Payroll Taxes for employees at the Childrens' Homes of the Tohono O'Odham Social Service Program (in the amount of 12% of salaries) are included in these budgets, and that Employee Benefits for all employees (in the amount of 16% of salaries) are to be part of the Executive Branch budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$213,408 are hereby appropriated from the FY-1992 General Revenues of the Nation to carry out the activities supported by this budget.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 25th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,501.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 57.0 NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [8] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
