4 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation operates Higher Education Services**
5 **under a PL 93-638 contract with the Bureau of Indian Affairs; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'Odham Nation by Resolution 91-268 did accept and**
7 **request the BIA to recontract for these services in FY-1992; and**

8 **WHEREAS, there is a delay in funding FY-1992 appropriations by the Federal**
9 **Government of the United States of America; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Education Department wishes to make payments as soon as**
12 **possible to all eligible students for their Fall 1991 subsistence costs;**
13 **and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Education Department has submitted a supplementary budget for**
15 **the Higher Education Program in the amount of \$91,711 (attached**
16 **hereto and incorporated by reference) for approval by the Legislative**
17 **Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Human Resources Development Committee of the Legislative**
20 **Council, with the oversight responsibility for the Education**
21 **Department and the Higher Education Program, has reviewed this**
22 **budget and appropriation request and recommended their approval and**
23 **adoption; and**

25 **WHEREAS, the Budget and Finance Committee of the Legislative Council has**
26 **reviewed this budget and appropriation request and recommended**

**NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono
O'Odham Nation that it approves the FY-1992 supplementary budget
submitted for the Higher Education Program by the Education
Department.**

**BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$91,711 are hereby
appropriated from the FY-1992 General Revenues of the Nation to
carry out the activities supported by this budget.**

**BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation
does request the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or any designated official
of the Nation ensure that any expenditure of this Tribal appropriation
be reimbursed from the BIA contract negotiated under Resolution
91-268 after such contract is implemented.**

**The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on
the 25th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with
a vote of 1,391.0 FOR; 167.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [8]
ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI
of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham
Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary
- Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of
June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
