8 **request the BIA to recontract for these services in FY-1992; and**

9 **WHEREAS, there is a delay in funding FY-1992 appropriations by the Federal**
10 **Government of the United States of America; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the Education Department wishes to make payments as soon as**
12 **possible to all eligible students for their October 1991 subsistence**
13 **costs; and**

15 **WHEREAS, the Education Department has submitted a supplementary budget for**
16 **the Employment Assistance Program (attached hereto and**
17 **incorporated by reference) for approval by the Legislative Council of**
18 **the Tohono O'Odham Nation with a request for an appropriation of**

21 **WHEREAS, the Human Resource Development Committee of the Legislative**

reviewed this budget and appropriation request and recommended their approval and adoption.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation that it approves the FY-1992 supplementary budget submitted for the Employment Assistance Program by the Education Department.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$15,000 are hereby appropriated from the FY-1992 General Revenues of the Nation to carry out the activities supported by this budget.

BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that the Legislative Council of the Tohono O'Odham Nation does request the Chairman, Vice-Chairman or any designated official of the Nation ensure that any expenditure of this Tribal appropriation be reimbursed from the BIA contract negotiated under Resolution 91-269 after such contract is implemented.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 25th. day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,558.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [9] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
