

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Adopting a Continuing Resolution Regarding San Lucy
District's FY-92 Budget)**

3 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District adopted Resolution No. 09-21-91, providing for**
4 **continued District operations, during FY-1992 pending development,**
5 **approval and implementation of an actual FY-92 District Budget; and**

6 **WHEREAS, the San Lucy District cited, in Resolution No. 09-21-91, the need to**
7 **incorporate elements of the San Lucy District's comprehensive Fiscal**
8 **and Reorganization Plans in the FY-92 budget; and**

10 **WHEREAS, San Lucy District will require additional time to incorporate such**
11 **provisions into the District's FY-92 budget; and**

12 **WHEREAS, fiscal year 1992 commences on October 1, 1991; and**

13 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interests of the San Lucy District and the Tohono**
14 **O'Odham Nation that San Lucy District be allowed to continue District**
15 **operations under the provisions of a continuing budget resolution for**
16 **FY-92, pending completion and implementation of a regular FY-92**
17 **District Budget.**

19 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED that the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council**
20 **does hereby approve San Lucy District's Continuing Budget Resolution**
21 **providing for continued district operations during fiscal year 1992**
22 **while pending submission, approval and implementation of an actual**
23 **San Lucy District Fiscal Year 1992 Budget.**

25 **BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Lucy District's FY-91 budget shall be utilized**
26 **as the basis for the interim budget authorized by the continuing**
27 **budget resolution.**

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the San Lucy District will prepare and present a comprehensive budget for FY-92 to the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council during the month of November 1991.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the provisions of this continuing budget resolution shall expire upon adoption and implementation of a comprehensive district budget, by both the San Lucy District and the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the authorization of this continuing budget resolution shall expire on December 1, 1991, any other terms of this resolution notwithstanding.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 25th day of September, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was presented with a vote of 1,286.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; 158.0 NOT VOTING; and 280.0 [11] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
