3 **WHEREAS, Public Law 100-485, the Family Support Act of 1988, was enacted**
4 **into law on October 13, 1988 to revise the AFDC Program to**
5 **emphasize work, child support, and family benefits, to amend Title IV**
6 **of the Social Security Act, to encourage and assist needy children and**
7 **parents under the new program to obtain the education, training and**
8 **employment needed to void long term welfare dependence; and**

10 **WHEREAS, on September 30, 1991 the JOBS Program was notified by the JOBS**
11 **Federal Representative that FY 1992 allocations would be issued late**
12 **due to the in-action of the U. S. Congress in approving FY 1992**
13 **allocation to all Federal agencies; and**

14 **WHEREAS, the JOBS Program staff has O'Odham AFDC clientele that are in need**
15 **of services to continue meeting their goals; and**

17 **WHEREAS, the JOBS Program has submitted a budget for staff salaries and**
18 **support costs to be approved in the interim; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the JOBS Program is requesting from the Tohono O'Odham Nation**
20 **interim funding in the amount of \$20,290.00 to continue to operate**
21 **for one quarter (10/01/91 to 12/31/91) or until the new JOBS grant**
22 **is approved and implemented; and**

24 **WHEREAS, the JOBS Program has secured confirmation from the Department of**
25 **Health & Human Services, Administration for Children & Family**
26 **representatives that all costs incurred by the Nation is reimbursable to**
27 **the Nation.**




The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 9th day of October, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,610.0 FOR; -0- AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 114.0 [4] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (f) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


