(Approving an Attorney Contract with the Law Firm of
Linden, Chapa & Fields)

3 **WHEREAS, during fiscal year 1991 the law firm of Linden, Chapa & Fields was**
4 **engaged by Attorney Contract (as amended by Amendment Nos. 1**
5 **and 2 thereto) to assist the Attorney General in providing legal**
6 **representation to the Tohono O'odham Nation with respect to two**
7 **lawsuits pending in the Nation's Tribal Court; and**

8 **WHEREAS, the Attorney Contract is for a term which ended on September 30,**
9 **1991; and**

11 **WHEREAS, the remaining lawsuit within the scope of the Attorney Contract is**
12 **Hickiwan District v. Arizona District Council of Assemblies of God**
13 **Church (the "Hickiwan Case"); and**

14 **WHEREAS, the Legislative Council approved a fiscal year 1992 Operating Budget**
15 **for the Office of Attorney General which included an allocation of**
16 **\$5,000 for an Attorney Contract with Linden, Chapa & Fields to**
17 **continue representation in the Hickiwan Case; and**

19 **WHEREAS, the Attorney General and the Domestic Affairs Committee recommend**
20 **approval of an Attorney Contract with Linden, Chapa & Fields in the**
21 **amount of \$5,000.**

23 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:**

- 24 1. **The Attorney Contract between the Tohono O'odham Nation and**
25 **the law firm of Linden, Chapa & Fields is approved for fiscal year**
26 **1992 in the amount of \$5,000 and in the form attached hereto.**
27 2. **The Chairman of the Nation is authorized and directed to execute**
28 **the Attorney Contract.**



The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of OCTOBER, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 1,607.5 FOR; 53.0 AGAINST; 63.5 NOT VOTING; and 04 ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 2 (a) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).




