

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL
(Approving Modification No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 1992 Operating
Budget of the Office of Attorney General and Appropriating \$4,221
to the General Account for Employee Benefits)**

3 **WHEREAS,** *by Resolution No. 91-416, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council*
4 *approved the Fiscal Year 1992 budgets for the Executive Branch,*
5 *including a budget of \$627,054 for the Office of Attorney General;*
6
7 *and*

8 **WHEREAS,** *Modification No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 1992 Operating Budget of the*
9 *Office of Attorney General transfers the sum of \$29,544 from the*
10 *Professional Services line item (060) to the Salaries and Wages line*
11 *item (010) and the Fringe Benefits line item (020), to be allocated as*
12 *follows: (1) increase the salary of the vacant Assistant Attorney*
13 *General position from \$36,889 to \$49,612, (2) adjust the salary of*
14 *the current Assistant Attorney General from \$36,889 to \$43,850, (3)*
15 *adjust the salary of the Paralegal from \$19,412 to \$26,107 (with the*
16 *position retitled as Tribal Law Counselor) and (4) increase the fringe*
17 *benefit amount by \$3,165 to account for the foregoing adjustments;*

21 **WHEREAS,** *the salary adjustments of \$26,379 will require an appropriation of*
22 *\$4,221 to the General Account for Employee Benefits (at the rate of*
23 *16%); and*

24 **WHEREAS,** *Section 2(A) of the Statute Creating the Office of Attorney General*
25 *(Resolution 326-89) authorizes the Attorney General to hire such staff*
26 *as are required to properly perform the responsibilities of the Office;*

3 **WHEREAS, Section 2(C) of such Statute provides that salaries of all staff in the**
4 **Office of Attorney General shall be established by the Legislative**
5 **Council; and**

7 **WHEREAS, the 1991 Position Reclassification Plan sets an entry level salary of**
8 **\$35,815 for an Assistant Attorney General who has no experience in**
9 **the practice of law and is not admitted to the Arizona Bar; and**

10 **WHEREAS, the proposed adjustments in the salaries of the Assistant Attorney**
11 **General are necessary to reasonably compensate an attorney with**
12 **eight years of experience who has agreed to accept an offer at the**
13 **adjusted salary, and to align the salary of the current Assistant**
14 **Attorney General to account for his five years of experience; and**

15
16 **WHEREAS, retitling of the position of Paralegal to Tribal Law Counselor and the**
17 **related salary adjustment are appropriate given the additional**
18 **professional responsibilities of such employee; and**

20 **WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval of this**
21 **Resolution by the Legislative Council.**



3. The 1991 Position Reclassification Plan is hereby amended to add the position of Tribal Law Counselor at an entry level salary of \$24,849 (including the 3% cost-of-living adjustment for Fiscal Year 1992).

4. The position of Paralegal in the Office of Attorney General is retitled as Tribal Law Counselor, and is authorized and approved at a salary of \$26,107.

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH day of OCTOBER, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 949.0 FOR; 609.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [5] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).
