4 **WHEREAS,** *by Resolution No. 91-416, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council*
5 *approved the Fiscal Year 1992 budgets for the Executive Branch,*
6 *including a budget of \$627,054 for the Office of Attorney General;*

9 **WHEREAS,** *by Resolution 91-474, the Legislative Council approved Modification*
10 *No. 1 to the Fiscal Year 1992 Operating Budget of the Office of*
11 *Attorney General; and*

12 **WHEREAS,** *Modification No. 2 to such Budget would partially fund the salary for*
13 *a Deputy Attorney General as a fourth attorney in the Office of*
14 *Attorney General; and*

16 **WHEREAS,** *full funding of a Deputy Attorney General's salary requires an*
17 *additional appropriation of \$29,544 to the Operating Budget of the*
18 *Attorney General's Office; and*

19 **WHEREAS,** *adding the Deputy Attorney General salary to the Office Budget will*
20 *require an appropriation of \$9,672 to the General Account for*
21 *Employee Benefits (at the rate of 16%); and*

23 **WHEREAS,** *Section 2(A) of the Statute Creating the Office of Attorney General*
24 *(Resolution 326-89) authorizes the Attorney General to hire such staff*
25 *as are required to properly perform the responsibilities of the Office;*

WHEREAS, Section 2(C) of such Statute provides that salaries of all staff in the Office of Attorney General shall be established by the Legislative Council; and

WHEREAS, the workload of the Office of Attorney General and protection of the Nation's legal interests justify creation of the position of Deputy Attorney General and funding for the position at the level proposed; and

WHEREAS, the Domestic Affairs Committee recommends approval of this Resolution by the Legislative Council.

NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED THAT:

- 1. Modification No. 2 to the Fiscal Year Operating Budget of the Office of Attorney General is hereby approved in the form attached hereto.**
- 2. The sum of \$29,544 is appropriated to the Fiscal Year 1992 Operating Budget of the Office of Attorney General.**
- 3. The sum of \$9,672 is appropriated to the General Account for Employee Benefits.**
- 4. The Fiscal Year 1992 Operating Budget of the Office of Attorney General is hereby approved in the total amount of \$656,598 and is authorized for expenditure in accordance with the attached Budget (which incorporates and allocates Modification Nos. 1 and 2, and the additional appropriation of \$29,544) .**

5. *The 1991 Position Reclassification Plan is hereby amended to add the position of Deputy Attorney General at an entry level salary of \$39,726 (including the 3% cost-of-living adjustment for Fiscal Year 1992), and the position of Deputy Attorney General is authorized and approved for the Office of Attorney General at the maximum salary reflected in the attached Budget.*

The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on the 10TH. day of OCTOBER, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present with a vote of 949.0 FOR; 609.0 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 166.0 [6] ABSENT, pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).


