the Water Projects Office to continue the activities that are supported by this budget.

BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$9,849.50, which is 16% of proposed
 salaries, is appropriated to the budget of the Executive Office to

19 provide employee benefits for Water Projects Office employees.

 BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that reimbursement for such funds will be sought through the Bureau of Reclamation.
