

**RESOLUTION OF THE TOHONO O'ODHAM LEGISLATIVE COUNCIL  
(FY 1992 Water Projects Office Interim Funding Request  
10/01/91 to 12/31/91)**

**RES. NO. 91-488**

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3 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Nation has operated the Water Projects Office*  
4 *to provide administrative services under a P.L. 93-638 contract with*  
5 *the Bureau of Reclamation for the development of projects in the*  
6 *Schuk Toak and San Xavier Districts through Contract No. 8-CS-32-*  
7 *00380 and Contract No. 8-CS-30-4830; and*

8 **WHEREAS,** *the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council by means of Resolutions*  
9 *91-284 and 91-285 approved budgets for FY 1992 to enable the*  
10 *continued operation of the Water Projects Office through the P.L.*  
11 *93-638 Contracts; and*

12 **WHEREAS,** *by means of the Resolutions 91-284 and 91-285 the Tohono*  
13 *O'Odham Legislative Council authorized one year extensions of the*  
14 *above mentioned Contracts; and*

15 **WHEREAS,** *the Bureau of Reclamation has not provided to the Tohono O'Odham*  
16 *Nation modifications to the contracts which were requested by the*  
17 *Nation in a manner consistent with the statutory requirements of P.L.*  
18 *93-638, as amended; and*

19 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office has submitted a budget for staff salaries and*  
20 *support costs to be approved in the interim while the contracts are*  
21 *negotiated with the Bureau of Reclamation; and*

22 **WHEREAS,** *the Water Projects Office is requesting from the Tohono O'Odham*  
23 *Nation interim funding in the amount of \$140,577 to enable the*  
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3 *operations of the Office to continue for one quarter (10/01/91 to*  
4 *12/31/91) or until the requested contract modifications are provided*  
5 *to the Tohono O'Odham Nation, reimbursement for such funds to be*  
6 *sought through the Bureau of Reclamation once the contract*  
7 *modifications are executed.*

9 ***NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT RESOLVED by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council that***  
10 ***it does hereby approve the funding request and authorized***  
11 ***expenditures in accordance with the attached budget.***

12 ***BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that funds in the amount of \$140,577 are hereby***  
13 ***approved from the FY 1992 General Revenues of the Nation to enable***  
14 ***the Water Projects Office to continue the activities that are supported***  
15 ***by this budget.***

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17 ***BE IT FURTHER RESOLVED that the amount of \$9,849.50, which is 16% of proposed***  
18 ***salaries, is appropriated to the budget of the Executive Office to***  
19 ***provide employee benefits for Water Projects Office employees.***

20 ***BE IT FINALLY RESOLVED that reimbursement for such funds will be sought through***  
21 ***the Bureau of Reclamation.***

23 ***The foregoing Resolution was passed by the Tohono O'Odham Legislative Council on***  
24 ***the 22ND. day of OCTOBER, 1991 at a meeting at which a quorum was present***  
25 ***with a vote of 1,660.5 FOR; 63.5 AGAINST; -0- NOT VOTING; and 01 ABSENT,***  
26 ***pursuant to the powers vested in the Council by Section 1 (d)(3) of Article VI of the***  
27 ***Constitution of the Tohono O'Odham Nation, adopted by the Tohono O'Odham Nation***  
28 ***on January 18, 1986; and approved by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian***  
***Affairs (Operations) on March 6, 1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18,***  
***1934 (48 Stat. 984).***


