(Tabling the San Lucy Farm in Lieu Tax Issue)

2 **WHEREAS, the Tohono O'odham Legislative Council set October 28, 1991 as a**
3 **special meeting to address the San Lucy Farm in Lieu Tax issue; and**

4 **WHEREAS, by Legislative Order No. 91-490, the Legislative Council did proceed**
5 **into closed session to address this item; and**

7 **WHEREAS, it is in the best interest of the Nation and the San Lucy District that**
8 **the appropriate oversight committees, interested entities be given**
9 **ample time to review and discuss this issue.**

10 **NOW, THEREFORE, BE IT ORDERED that the San Lucy Farm in Lieu Tax Issue is**
11 **hereby tabled and referred to the Budget & Finance Committee;**
12 **Agriculture Committee; San Lucy District and the Tohono O'Odham**
13 **Farming Authority to meet and discuss this issue.**

15 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that all documents as referred to in Section 19 of the**
16 **Tohono O'Odham Farming Authority's Restated Plan of Operation be**
17 **submitted to the above mentioned for review and discussion.**

18 **BE IT FURTHER ORDERED that this item will be returned to the Legislative Council**
19 **during the November General Session.**

27 **by the Acting Deputy Assistant Secretary - Indian Affairs (Operations) on March 6,**
28 **1986, pursuant to Section 16 of the Act of June 18, 1934 (48 Stat. 984).**
